

Men's Match Play

1. All matches are to be played off the white tees.
2. Handicaps to be used are official CPGA handicaps for the white tees on the day of you match. Strokes given will be based on 80% of the difference between the players handicaps rounded to the nearest whole number. For example: If Player A has a factor of 6.6 (which is then calculated to course handicap of $6.6 \times (124/113) = 7.24$ rounded to Handicap of 7 off the whites), and Player B has a factor of 11.5 (which is then calculated to a course handicap of $11.5 \times (124/113) = 12.61$ rounded to 13 Handicap off the whites). The difference between the two handicaps is $13 - 7 = 6$ then 80% of 6 is 4.8 so rounded to nearest whole number you get 5. Player B would get a stroke on Handicap holes 1 to 5.
3. Due to privacy laws we are unable to list phone numbers for the players on the draw sheet. It is the responsibility of both players to contact each other to set up their match. If you need assistance in contacting a player please ask in the Pro Shop and they will assist you with contact info for your opponent.
4. All matches are to be played under the 2019 Rules of Golf published by the RCGA and local rules displayed on the score card. In addition play lift, clean and place in the short cut fairway portion of your hole only, in all other areas play the ball down.
5. Any matches that are tied at the conclusion of 18 holes will proceed to Hole 1 for sudden death playoff, if tied after that continue to Hole 2 and so on. The player receiving strokes will receive them in the sudden death playoff on the appropriate handicap holes.
6. Please ensure you update the draw sheet on the Club Captains Board with your match results.
7. **All matches are to be played within the 2 week window allotted, if the match is not played the committee will determine the player to move on. There will be no extensions allowed for any reason.**
